

Back to School Supply List for Grades 6, 7, 8 - Middle School

Note: Students need to keep a supply all year ~ it's much cheaper to buy them now and keep them at home to stock up!
Middle School Students often run out of pencils or glue by April and you can save money by buying extra now!

- ❖ NIV Bible ~ required for every student!!
- ❖ 2 combination padlocks for 6th/7th grades ~ 1 for 8th grade
 - Notes about padlocks:
 - all combinations must be given to the homeroom teacher on the first day of school, so don't open the padlock until you get here – the numbers may be lost!!!!
 - **students must have a lock on their locker at all times – so buy extra at the beginning of the school year in the event a combination is forgotten or lock gets stuck**
- ❖ 2 packages of 3 x 5 index cards
- ❖ "F" drive (also known as a "flash drive" or a "zip drive") – no more than 4 gb needed
- ❖ Dictionary ~ required for every student!!
- ❖ Three 3 ring binders (1 to 1 1/2" binders)
- ❖ 5 packages of loose leaf notebook paper (wide rule)
- ❖ 1 packages of subject dividers (1 dozen per pack)
- ❖ Markers ~ thin / or colored pencils
- ❖ Crayons
- ❖ 3 glue sticks
- ❖ 4 packages of *sharpened* pencils
- ❖ 1 large eraser
- ❖ 1 pencil pouch (with 3 holes to fit into binder)
- ❖ 1 package of pens
- ❖ Highlighter
- ❖ White out
- ❖ 3 pocket folders ~ plastic ones hold up best
- ❖ 12 black & white composition books – used for all 6 subjects ☺
- ❖ Calculator – scientific kind (includes functions like pi, square root, etc)
- ❖ Protractor
- ❖ 1 ruler with metric measure
- ❖ 1 box of soft tissues
- ❖ 1 bottle of antibacterial hand gel (6th grade only)
- ❖ 1 pack of antibacterial hand wipes (7th grade only)
- ❖ 5 large book covers

*Additional items may be necessary throughout the year as students use up/misplace items.
Assignment books will be purchased by the school for each student.*

A Note About Lockers: *If the student plans on decorating the inside of his/her locker, only themes and artists that are appropriate may be used. Lockers are the property of the school and no expectation of privacy is implied.*

Students are expected to keep lockers organized and are responsible for them. Periodic locker checks will occur during the school year.

Cell phones, only if a parent feels that the student needs to bring them to school, must be dropped off in the office each morning. *The student is responsible for picking up the phone & signing it out in the afternoon before leaving. Cell phones are not the responsibility of Calvary. **NO ELECTRONICS in school (iPods, etc)***
